INFORMATION FOR PROSPECTIVE MEMBERS

- The Club, which was instituted in 1842 welcomes gents, ladies and juniors and has approximately 680 members. It is run by a Council of up to twelve elected members appointed at the Annual General Meeting in November of each year.
- At present there is no waiting list for membership, and no entry fee is charged. Current rates of Annual Subscription, for the year ended 31st January 2017 are as follows:

Adults residing within 50 miles of Carnoustie	£165
Adults residing outwith 50 miles, including Overseas	£150
Senior Members aged over 65	£110
Youth Members aged 18 to 25	£110
Junior Members under 18	£ 25
Social Members	£ 30

Social Membership is only available to persons **not** holding a season ticket to play over the Carnoustie golf courses. Family membership is available at a subscription of £220 per couple plus £15 for each eligible child. There are a limited number of lockers available to members at an annual rental of £24. Alternatively, members can secure the use of a locker for the whole term of their membership on payment of a one-off fee of £150.

It is stressed that membership of the Golf Club does not give any playing rights over the Carnoustie golf courses. These rights are obtained by the purchase of an annual season ticket from Carnoustie Golf Links Management Limited which administers the courses on behalf of Angus Council. At present there are waiting lists for most categories of season ticket, and only residents of Angus County are being admitted to these waiting lists. Club members resident outwith Angus County can obtain green fees at guest rates by playing in the company of local members. A separate explanation of the procedure to be adopted for this is attached.

- Application forms for membership can be obtained from the Club bar or from the Secretary, can be downloaded from the Club website at www.carnoustiegolfclub.co.uk or can be sent out by post or e-mail. Applications are considered by the Club Council at their meetings which are normally held on the last Friday of each month.

- Competitions are run throughout the year on all three courses each Saturday and Sunday, on either the Championship or Burnside plus the Buddon every Tuesday and on either the Burnside or the Buddon every Wednesday. In addition to the Club Championship, the Club runs six adult, four junior and two senior knock-out competitions each year and also plays several matches at all three levels against local Clubs.
- The Clubhouse is normally open from 6.30 am to 11 pm. In the summer the bar opening hours are generally 11 am to 11 pm Monday to Friday and 10.00 am to 11 pm Saturday and Sunday. In winter we usually close much earlier. Adult Members are permitted to sign in up to 3 guests at any one time, whose names and addresses should be entered in the visitors' book
- There is a fairly informal dress code in operation which requires that members and their guests should dress with a degree of conventionality. Details of unacceptable items of dress are on the Club notice boards.
- The Club's catering facilities are franchised and open to members and their guests and visiting golfers throughout the year. Evening meals should be booked in advance.
- There are a number of social functions throughout the year and tickets can be obtained from the bar. These functions are advertised on the notice boards.
